

As of this writing our annual council Christmas party on December 19 at 7pm is still on, but as I have said with the way the COVID numbers keep slowly going up,



#### **PARISH NEWS**

Dear Brothers,

Christmas is always a very busy time of the year for everyone, especially at church. This year will certainly be no different however with COVID, it's taking on a whole new level of busy and crazy.

The one thing that Sacred Heart has always prided itself on is that it is a very welcoming environment where all are welcome to worship. You can imagine the difficulty we face then when this year for **Christmas Eve and Christmas Day** celebrations, we have to have an online registration to attend mass. The way this will work is as follows: the first 120 registered will have seats in the main body of the church. (ushers will be instructed on where and how to seat parishioners, you may not simply sit where you wish, except those who are physically challenged). The next 15 registered will be seated in the choir loft and the last 50 registered will be seated in the lower church hall where a screen will be set up to livestream mass.

Ushers will be stationed outside the church and will have your name and seating location. Your name MUST BE ON THE LIST in order to attend worship. I recommend arriving to church early as once the Gospel is proclaimed, the doors will be closed and no one will be permitted in. I have a serious responsibility to each of you and myself to make us as safe as possible during these challenging times. We do not want to turn anyone away for sure, thus with early registrations, it will

enable us to see if we need to add a mass to handle a possible overflow.

Now this is all subject to change at the last minute if the COVID numbers continue to increase and churches and houses of worship are once again forced to close their doors, in which case we would have to return to only an online streamed version of mass. Let's pray that the numbers shrink and we are able to all come together to celebrate the birth of Christ.

On behalf of the entire staff at Sacred Heart, I would like to wish everyone a very merry and blessed Christmas.


